New Minimum Wage Effective July 24, 2007

President George W. Bush signed the federal Fair Minimum Wage Act of 2007 on May 25, 2007, which amended the federal Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the federal minimum wage incrementally from \$5.15 per hour to \$7.25 per hour. The act raises the federal minimum wage in three steps: to \$5.85 on July 24, 2007; to \$6.55 on July 24, 2008; and, to \$7.25 on July 24, 2009.

On March 5, 2007, Governor John Hoeven signed H.B. 1454 raising the state minimum wage. House Bill 1454 is triggered by the federal Fair Minimum wage Act of 2007, raising the state minimum wage in the same amounts and at the same time frames as the federal minimum wage increases, with an effective date to be the same date of the increase in the federal minimum wage. The North Dakota Department of Labor received notice from the North Dakota Legislative Council dated June 6, 2007 that the chairman of the Legislative Council has certified the effective date of H.B. 1454 to be July 24, 2007, thereby raising the state minimum wage on that date to \$5.85 per hour on that date, with the same incremental increases noted under the federal minimum wage.

Technology Tip

Microsoft Office Keyboard Shortcuts

Shortcut keys help provide an easier and usually quicker method of navigating and using computer software programs. This is a list of some of the most common Microsoft Office keyboard shortcuts:

- 1. **Ctrl+Z** is the wonderful undo combo. It basically undoes your last action. Programs vary in the number of times you can undo something, but some will let you Ctrl+Z all the way back to the beginning. And, of course, there is a redo command, just use Ctrl+Y.
- 2. Ctrl+B, Ctrl+I, or Ctrl+U apply bold, italics, or underline to highlighted text, respectively.
- 3. Ctrl+P prints what you have open in an active window.
- 4. **Ctrl+Backspace** erases an entire word at a time, instead of a letter. **Ctrl+up or down arrows** let you scroll an entire paragraph at a time, instead of one line, and **Ctrl+Shift+up or down arrow** will select an entire paragraph.
- 5. **Ctrl+Enter** inserts a page break in Word.
- 6. Alt+Ctrl+C inserts the copyright symbol ©, Alt+Ctrl+R inserts the registered trademark symbol ®, and Alt+Ctrl+T makes the trademark symbol ™.
- 7. In Outlook, you can move to a different section by using these shortcuts: **Ctrl+1** switches to the Mail window, **Ctrl+2** switches to the Calendar, **Ctrl+3** to Contacts, **Ctrl+4** to Tasks, and **Ctrl+5** to Notes
- 8. Ctrl+Shift+M starts a new message in Outlook and you can use Ctrl+Shift+C for a new contact.
- 9. In Outlook e-mail, use Ctrl+N to write a new message, Ctrl+R to reply to a message.
- 10. In Excel, **Ctrl+** enters the date. If you use Excel frequently, it would be a good idea to save the Excel keyboard shortcuts in your Favorites. You can find the Excel shortcuts in http://office.microsoft.com/en-us/excel/HP052037811033.aspx.
